1. See the attached Tentative Agenda. We will begin at 9:30 am on Thursday (16th) and at 9:00 am on Friday (17th).
2. Driving Directions
 - a. From I-15
 - b. Exit to I-80 East
 - c. Exit #124 – State Street/US 89
 - d. North on State Street
 - e. South City Campus is at 1575 S State Street (on the East side of the road)

4. Parking
 - a. UHESA will cover your parking expenses, and we are planning to have an area cordoned off in the Parking Lot (East of the building) for UHESA Delegates
 - b. If you prefer, you may park at your hotel and Mike Blain has offered to provide a shuttle van to get you to the conference – Please contact him (Michael.Blain@slcc.edu) if you are interested in this.
5. Cost of the Conference
 - a. \$30 per attendee. The actual cost is higher, but UHESA will cover the remainder. You will receive a bill from UHESA after the conference for all attendees from your institution.
6. Lodging: For those who wish to stay in a hotel, Salt Lake City offers many options. These are some options we are aware of, but you are welcome to shop around.
 - a. Quality Inn & Suites of Murray (440 W 5300 S, 801-506-0215, www.qualityinnsouthsaltlake.com) offers a rate of \$64 + tax through SLCC. This is a bit of a distance from the SLCC South City Campus, but should be safe and nice. UHESA Delegate Julia Ellis (Julia.Ellis@slcc.edu) may be able to provide more information.
 - b. The University of Utah Guest House (<http://www.universityguesthouse.com/>) may still have rooms. This hotel is right in the middle of the UofU campus. Normal prices are \$129, but UHESA Delegate Jan Lovett (Jan.Lovett@utah.edu) may be able to get you a better deal.
 - c. SLCC's hosting folks provided information about the Ramada Inn right off I-80 at 2455 State Street (just blocks from SLCC South City Campus). Some have said this is a less than 100% safe neighborhood. \$95 gov. rate or \$79.99 online (<http://www.ramada.com/hotels/utah/salt-lake-city/ramada-limited-salt-lake-city/hotel-overview?cid=local>)
