 losing the programs.
- Extension Programs. CEU & Snow would get some additional funding to maintain support. This item will be discussed further at the May meeting at College of Eastern Utah.
- As the legislature announced, no rainy day funds are being used. An invite was extended to all
 campuses and UHESA delegates to write thank-you letters to the legislature. Butch will draft a
 letter from UHESA that will go to the legislature the board will comment during the May mtg.
